<b>Publication Information</b>	<i>Change this information as soon as you create your video.</i> Video Title: <u>Firstname L.: Where I’m From</u> Producer: <u>Firstname L.</u> <i>(Firstname is your first name; L. is your last initial.)</i>	<b>5</b>	
<b>Title Text Frame</b>	<i>Your first text frame must be the title frame:</i> Header: <u>Where I’m From</u> Text: <u>by Firstname L.</u>	<b>5</b>	
<b>Poem Text Frames</b>	-Each line of your poem should have at least one text frame in your video. Most lines of poetry will take two or three text frames to complete. -You must follow the model poem/template. -Your text should break at <i>meaningful</i> places. This includes separation between “Header” and “Text,” as well as between two separate text frames.	<b>60</b>	
<b>Usage &amp; Mechanics</b>	This includes spelling, punctuation, capitalization, grammar, word usage, etc. <i>Follow the model poem by George Ella Lyon!</i>	<b>20</b>	
<b>Pictures/ Video Clips</b>	-At least one picture or video must be placed before and after each text frame (except first and last). You should not have two text frames in a row anywhere in your video. -Your pictures and videos should fit the context of the poem. They should serve to illustrate and illuminate your poem.	<b>25</b>	
<b>Music</b>	-Your music should fit the tone of your poem/pictures/videos. -Check lyrics for appropriateness. If in doubt, don’t use it!	<b>10</b>	
<b>Final Text Frame</b>	<i>Your final text frame must be the end frame:</i> Header: <u>The End</u> (no Text)	<b>5</b>	
<b>Creativity/Design</b>	This includes selection and placement of style, music, images, videos, etc. <i>Have a reason for putting things where you do!</i>	<b>20</b>	
<b>Appropriateness</b>	EVERY component (pictures, text, lyrics, videos, etc.) of your video should be appropriate for school and for sharing online.	<i>up to</i> <b>-100%</b>	
<b>Submitting This Rubric</b>	If you don’t submit this rubric by the class period following the due date, you will lose 20%.	<b>-30</b>	
<b>Submitting Video Via Email</b>	If you don’t share your video with me via email by the due date and time, you will lose 20%. Follow the directions!	<b>-30</b>
